Nevada Aging and Disability Services Division/Developmental Services (ADSD/DS) is currently recruiting for full-time contracted **Program Behavior Analyst** positions in **Reno/Sparks** and **Las Vegas, Nevada**.

Developmental Services (DS) is comprised of three regional centers in Nevada who serve over 8000 individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities (IDD). Desert Regional Center (DRC) serves over 5600 people in urban Clark County, including the Las Vegas metro area. Sierra Regional Center (SRC) serves over 1600 people in Washoe County, including Reno and Sparks. Rural Regional Center (RRC) serves over 800 people throughout the rest of Nevada through eight (8) offices with headquarters in Carson City. All regional centers operate Community Services programs including community-based Residential Support, Jobs and Day Training, and Family Support services.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Master's degree in behavioral analysis, education, or psychology.
- Certification as a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) as issued by the Board Analyst Certification Board.
- Current licensure, or eligible for licensure, as a BCBA through the Nevada Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Board.
- 24 months or more experience in the practice of behavioral analysis.
